- I. **Israel Leaves Egypt – Exodus – “\_\_\_\_\_”**
- A. Crossing the Red Sea – Exodus 14:1-31
  - B. Bitter waters made sweet – Exodus 15:22-26
    - 1. Type and Shadow of Jesus Christ
  - C. Manna and Quail given – Exodus 16:1-36
    - 1. God’s supernatural provision – showing His character and desire for His people to depend upon Him.
- II. **Moses at Mount Sinai**
- A. Law and Tabernacle plans – Exodus 19:1 thru 40:38 for this Nation of people who desired to follow Jehovah God – God set the framework of this.
    - 1. Type and Shadow – 1 Corinthians 10:1-2 & 10:6,11; Hebrews 8:5
      - We will pick the importance of the Tabernacle after the next point.
  - B. \_\_\_\_\_ Spies sent out – Numbers 13 - 14
    - 1. Two came with positive report, 10 with negative
    - 2. Caused \_\_\_\_\_ of wandering – because of unbelief
    - 3. That doubtful generation had to die off to enter in!
- III. **God makes a covenant with Israel – “\_\_\_\_\_”**
- A. The Ten Commandments – Exodus 20:1-17
  - B. A Holy People – Separated unto God - God always desired people to worship in (Fellowship, Adam and Eve) relationship – Exodus 25:8
  - C. Teach your Children there is One True God – Deuteronomy 6:4-9
  - D. The Tabernacle – the place of worship - Exodus 25:1-27
  - E. Priests offer sacrifices and interpret Law - Exodus 28: 1-29, 46
  - F. Sacrificial offerings – Leviticus 1:1-9, 24
  - G. The Sabbath – a Jewish day of rest and joy – Exodus 20:8-11
  - H. Special Feast Days – Leviticus 23:1-44; 25:1-55
  - I. Moral Laws – Books of Exodus and Leviticus
  - J. Dietary Laws – Leviticus 11:1-47
  - K. Customs and Ceremonies Exodus and Leviticus
- IV. **God Dwells with His Covenant People – Man’s approach to a Holy God – the Tent of meeting**
- A. God Dwells in the middle of His people – Numbers 1:50 thru 3:39
  - B. A new way to Worship – approach to God – Hebrews 9:1-9
    - 1. \_\_\_\_\_ – the place of death and bloodshed  
- Sin had to be covered by blood before man could fellowship with a Holy God – Hebrews 9:22, Leviticus 17:11, John 1:29
    - 2. \_\_\_\_\_ – A ceremonial washing of the Priests was required before ministering at the Brazen Alter or entering the Tabernacle – Exodus 30:18,20 – Symbolized N.T. Baptism- 1 Peter 3:20-21
    - 3. Alter of Incense – The Perfumed fragrance of incense was offered to God twice a day, morning and evening.
    - 4. \_\_\_\_\_ – Twelve loaves of unleavened bread sprinkled with frankincense were renewed each Sabbath and eaten by the priests. Became a continual thank offering to God.
    - 5. \_\_\_\_\_ – Provided light for priests to perform duties in the Holy Place. Oil in lamps burned continually.
    - 6. \_\_\_\_\_ God’s presence dwelled above the “Mercy Seat” between the cherubim. Inside the Ark were the Tables of Law, a pot of manna, and later Aaron’s rod that budded.
  - C. Was a shadow of Good this to come! – Hebrews 8:5; 9:8 thru 10:1
