V. John the Baptist – The Forerunner of Christ

A. The coming of John the Baptist was prophesied in the Old Testament

1. Is 40:3; Mal. 3:1 and a N.T. reference – Luke 3:2-6

- The Jews knew all these Scriptures about the coming Messiah, but refused to acknowledge His coming the first time as a servant or sacrifice.

2. John's message was REPENT FOR THE KINGDOM OF GOD IS AT HAND!

3. John preached a message of Baptism of Repentance – Matthew 3:5-12; Mark 1:4-8; Luke 3:1-18; John 1:19-28

- This was different than Christian Baptism
Commanded by Jesus – Matthew 28:19
