- B. Ancient Blood Covenants
- C. Abraham's \_\_\_\_\_ – Circumcision – involved blood
- D. The Passover Lamb – \_\_\_\_\_ on the door posts
- E. Blood Covenant for Sin
  - 1. Luke 22:20
    - This is the first of two ordinances observed by Christians  
Referred to as Communion
- F. Paul Referenced this in his discussion on Public worship
  - 1. I Corinthians 11:23-34
  - 2. This taking of the wine and bread is a Symbolic, visual reminder of our \_\_\_\_\_
  - 3. There is no law as to how frequent and or often this should be observed – The Apostle Paul made reference to give as a hint on this issue – “as often as you do this” I Corinthians 11:26
    - Taking communion does not save you! It is a simple ordinance of remembering – This ceremony should be scared and reverence by all redeemed believers
    - Communion service should also be a time of examination – where we realize the price that was paid, and we commit to identifying and living out our Christian faith in renewed passion and thankfulness – I Corinthians 11:28-29

#### V. Provisions of the New Covenant

- A. Healing
  - 1. Matthew 8:17; I Peter 2:24; Luke 9:11; Acts 10:38  
James 5:15
- B. Scriptures pattern of Healing
  - 1. Anoint with oil – James 5:14-16
  - 2. Lay Hands on the Sick – Mark 16:15-18
  - 3. United prayer – Matthew 18:19-20
  - 4. Personal prayer of faith – Mark 11:22-24; John 14:12-14
  - 5. Gifts of Healing (we will be covering this more later) I Corinthians 12:9

#### VI. “IT IS FINISHED!” – JOHN 19:30

- A. At the Cross of Calvary, the sinless Lamb of God was sacrificed for the Remission of sins
  - 1. Matthew 26:28
  - 2. Hebrews 9:22
- B. A new way to God! \_\_\_\_\_!  
– Jesus restores us back to relationship with Father! – Matthew 27:50-51
