**Bible Point:**

Jesus stands up for God,  
so we stand up for God.

*"Don't be selfish; don't try to impress others.  
Be humble, thinking of others as better than yourselves" Philippians 2:3*

**Family Together Time**

Standing up for God isn't about judging what everyone is doing. It's about doing what's right and speaking out when people put God's name on something that's wrong; something that would hurt God's heart.

- What's something you've seen people do that you thought might hurt God's heart? How does that make you feel?
- Tell about a time you stood up for a friend.
- For one meal this week, move your chairs aside and eat the meal standing up at the table. You may need to get step stools for little ones to stand on. Talk about how it feels to stand up while eating.
- Talk about how it feels to stand up for God.
- This week, sing "[Stand Together](#)" as you praise God together.

In "[Stand Up](#)", Jesus had to act because the people were disrespecting God.

- Why do you think it is was okay for Jesus to flip a table, even though that's something you would normally get in trouble for?
- Aside from flipping tables, what could you do to stand up for God?
